1. What is *sin*?

→ Sin is the transgression of the law (the word of God).

1 John 3:4

2. Who is a *sinner*?

→ For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God.

Romans 3:23

→ Behold, I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me.

Psalm 51:5

→ If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves.

1 John 1:8

3. What is the *result* of sin?

→ For the wages of sin is death...

Romans 6:23

→ When lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin; and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death.

James 1:15

→ And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened; which is the book of Life.

Revelation 20:12

→ And whosoever was not found written in the book of Life was cast into the lake of fire.

Revelation 20:15

→ But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone; which is the second death.

4. *Who* can forgive my sins?

→ This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners.

1 Timothy 1:15

→ The Son of Man (Jesus Christ) hath power on earth to forgive sins.

Mark 2:10

→ For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

John 3:16

→ The Lord (Lord Jesus) forgiveth all thine iniquities.

Psalms 103:3

5. *How* can my sins be forgiven?

→ If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

1 John 1:9

→ The blood of Jesus Christ cleanses us from all sin.

1 John 1:7

→ For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

Romans 10:13

If you are not yet born again, I sincerely pray to God that He would speak to you about being saved. I would like to show you the simple A-B-C steps of being born again.

C- Confess your sins to the Lord and ask His forgiveness. Pray to God that you are a sinner and need His help to be freed from the burden of sin.

B- Believe that Lord Jesus Christ came into this world to seek and save you from your sinful condition.

A- Accept Him as your Lord and Savior. Ask Him to come into your heart and remove sin from your heart and to dwell in you from hereafter.
